**Dates:** Monday 13<sup>th</sup> to Friday 17<sup>th</sup> October 2014

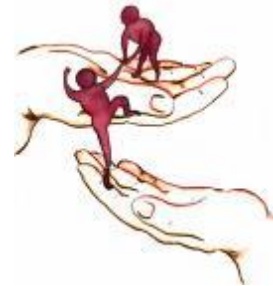
**Venue:** Frank Barnes School for the Deaf, Jubilee Waterside Centre,
