







BSL Primary Curriculum Meeting Record

10th Meeting Friday 13th September 2019

Topic: Illustrations

<u>WFD Update:</u> Catherine Drew explained that she submitted a paper to the WFD last year (October 2018) about this BSL Curriculum and the design process. The paper was accepted as a Poster Presentation at the World Federation of the Deaf Congress in Paris, July 2019. She created a poster presentation explaining the work that we have been doing and all could see in the meeting.

All asked for the poster presentation to be sent via email so that others could share with their colleagues/settings.

<u>Logo Design:</u> After the new logo was announced, received lots of positive feedback complimenting the logo and supporting our progress with the curriculum. Approximately 3K people have liked this logo!

However, there was some feedback about the "sign for curriculum being drawn on the 'wrong' side / left handed when it should be right handed!

Discussed whether we wanted to take on board the feedback or keep the logo – all agreed that we are happy having the left-handed sign for curriculum as it was our intention (3 members of our meeting group are left handed!) and it is aesthetically fitting with the spelling of 'c'.
