

BSL Primary Curriculum Meeting Record

4th & 5th Meeting
Friday 13th July 2018

Topic: BSL Curriculum Guidance

BSL Curriculum Format: Discussed what format / template we should use/follow. We looked at some examples and agreed to use a similar format to the DfE National Curriculum format as this is what is used for all subjects and is clear, easy to read.

Review Nursery & Reception Learning Outcomes: We read through the learning outcomes that we drafted in the last meeting and made final draft amendments. Now it needs to be typed up again and be sent out for us to start using as soon as possible with our EYFS settings. Agreed not to share with the public yet because this needs to be reviewed after we have used this for at least 6 months and distributed after any further amendments that needs to be made.

Teachers' Guidance to using the Curriculum: We agreed that the final BSL Curriculum itself will have various information so that teachers and schools who take on the BSL Curriculum will have a document to read through much like the National Curriculum.

We worked in groups and wrote draft papers for different sections:

- BSL (What is BSL? Explanation)
- Purpose of Study (Why learn BSL? Explanation)
- Aims (Explanation to what the aims are)
- Productive Skills (Explanation)
- Receptive Skills (Explanation)
- BSL Curriculum in Schools (When/how guidance)
- Word List (List of expected vocabulary used in different Key Stages)
- Glossary (Drafted a list of examples – explanation to terminology used)

Catherine Drew will have all the paperwork typed up and sent around for proof reading before final distribution later.

Who's Who: All double checked our details and moved some of us around so that we have clear groups:

- Primary Group
- Secondary Group
- Information Group

Agreed that Catherine Drew would email everyone a copy of this so that we can all see the same information.

Schools & Logos: Some have sent their school logo for us to use in our templates and for inclusion in the BSL Curriculum document. Some have not sent their logos, it is up to us to send our logos or not have it included.

Agreed that we would like one logo for the BSL Curriculum, need a volunteer to design this and all to share ideas, to be discussed at the next opportunity.
