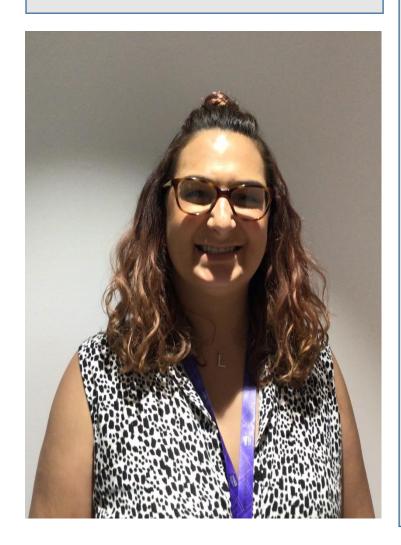
Deaf Awareness tips:
